## Parliamentary Confederation of the Americas Calls for Solidarity with Haiti

January 13, 2010 – The Parliamentary Confederation of the Americas (COPA) and its member parliamentarians from across the American continent are saddened and dismayed by the tragedy afflicting the people of Haiti.

In the wake of the violent earthquake that rocked Port-au-Prince and the surrounding area, the country is in a state of shock in the face of the destruction of its capital city and the collapse of the National Palace and Parliament, both highly symbolic institutions for the Haitian people.

Haiti needs concrete and speedy assistance, and COPA calls on all its member Parliaments to urge their governments to take immediate action.
