

PARLIAMENTARY CONFEDERATION OF THE AMERICAS EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL ASSEMBLY QUERÉTARO, MEXICO JULY 20–25, 2010

The legislators of the Americas gathered together in Querétaro, Mexico, for an Extraordinary General Assembly of the Parliamentary Confederation of the Americas (COPA),

Considering

That one of the objectives of COPA is to promote and strengthen democracy and the recognition of democratic values through the institutions created for that purpose, while defending respect for the sovereignty and the right to self-determination of peoples;

Considering

That it is necessary for COPA countries to maintain a dialogue reflecting respect and solidarity, and to devote more energy toward fostering understanding and conflict resolution through diplomacy;

Considering

That the Venezuelan delegation of COPA has expressed concerns regarding the recent dispute with Colombia;

Have resolved

To encourage the governments of Venezuela and Colombia to create conditions conducive to establishing a dialogue to foster peace and understanding between the peoples and governments of these two countries;

To offer their assistance if the Venezuelan and Colombian governments request it in order to help their two countries to reach a consensus.
