RESOLUTION

The members of the Committee on the Environment and Sustainable Development of the Parliamentary Confederation of the Americas (COPA), gathered in Guanajuato, State of Guanajuato, Mexico on September 10, 2015.

RECOGNIZING: That the 21st Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP21), to be held in Paris, France from November 30 to December 11, 2015 is a crucial meeting, as it must lead to the adoption of a new international climate agreement applicable to all countries and aimed at keeping global warming below 2 °C.

DECIDE TO

Article 1: Recommend that COPA, particularly the members of the

Committee on the Environment and Sustainable

Development, participate in COP21.

Article 2: Ask the President of COPA and the Chair of the Committee

on the Environment and Sustainable Development to

apply to the Convention's secretariat for accreditation and

forward invitations to COPA members.
